



Sportaccord Martial Art and Combat Sports Games

Beijing 28 August - 4 September 2010

This is the 1st edition of these Games. The abbreviation of these games are **Sportaccord MA & CS Games**.

General information

These games must not be mixed with World Games, a name that many use by mistake.

The promoter cover all travelcosts (from / to Beijing), accommodation and transport for each sport up to 120 people. The promoter also pay all expences concerning security, medical care, volunteers, mediaplan etc. This includes the number of competitor which will be about 80, and rest of the staff like coaches, referees/judges and officials. The number of 120 people is a number that have been agreed on by the Martial Art Coordination group during the bid organizing.

The total budget for the promoter of these games are about USD 9.35 million

Technical Delegate for Kickboxing

Espen Lund will be Technical Delegate for our sport and will report to the WAKO Board and will together with the President put together an Organizing Committee.

Only martial arts federations member of Sportaccord (former called GAISF) are allowed to participate. Also, these games are not an open games for other international organizations practicing our and our colleagues sport.

WAKO will participate in three disciplines and with following weight categories:

- Semicontact: 63, 69, 74, 79, 84 (Men) and 55, 60 (Women).
- Fullcontact: 63, 67, 71, 75, 81 (Men) and 56, 60 (Women).
- Low-Kick: 63, 67, 71, 75, 81 (Men) and 56, 60 (Women).

Qualification for athletes

The qualification will be during the World Championships 2009 where the 4 best will be invited. If any injuries or withdrawl, the next competitor will be drawn.

Venues of Competition

Beijing has many competition venues with complete facilities and equipment and high standard conditions that can fully meet the requirements for hosting international sports events. 1. National Indoor Stadium

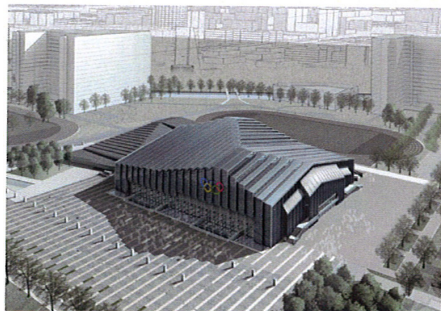

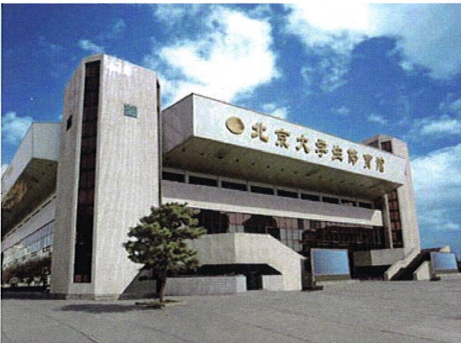
